- (i) Schedule – 2: Form of Agreement: Clause 3.4-Liability of the consultant: Sub-Clause 3.4.3.(ii) (Page 62 of 93).

For any direct loss or damage that exceeds (a) the Agreement Value set forth in Clause 6.1.2 6.1.1 of this Agreement or (b) the proceeds the consultants may be entitled to recover from any insurance maintained by the consultant to cover such a liability, whichever of (a) or (b) is higher.

- (ii) Appendix – 1: Technical Proposal- Form – 1: Letter of Proposal (Point Number 6) (Page 79 of 93)

I/We certify that in the last three years, we ~~or any of our Associates~~ have neither failed to perform on any assignment or contract, as evidenced by imposition of a penalty by an arbitral or judicial authority or a judicial pronouncement or arbitration award against the Applicant, nor been expelled from any project or contract by any public authority nor have had any contract terminated by any public authority for accepted breach on our part which in any manner may impair our provision of the services under the proposed engagement.
