NOTIFICATION

S.O... whereas Motor Glider VT-GJH of Government of Jharkhand met with an Accident at Deoghar on 07.08.2013.

And whereas it appears to the Central Government that it is expedient to investigate and determine the causes and contributory factors leading to the accident and make recommendations to avoid reoccurrence of such accidents in future.

Now, in exercise of the powers conferred by the Rule 11 (1) of the Aircraft (Accident and Incidents Investigation) Rules 2012, the Central Government hereby directs that a formal inquiry of the said accident be held.

The Central Government is pleased to appoint a Committee of Inquiry headed by Sh. A X Joseph, Assistant Director, AAIB with Sh. K Ramachandran, ASO, AAIB as member to inquire into the circumstances of this accident.

The committee will also take the assistance of other experts/agencies whenever required.

The headquarters of the Committee will be at New Delhi.

The Committee will complete its inquiry and submit its report to the Central Government preferably within six months.
