Important Policy decisions taken and major achievements during the month:

1. Ministry of Civil Aviation

- A. Passengers carried by domestic airlines during Jan-Sept, 2019 were **1058.91 lakhs** as against **1027.93 lakhs** during the corresponding period of previous year thereby registering annual growth of **3.01%** and monthly growth of **1.18%**
- B. Bilateral Talks between Government of India and the Aeronautical Authority of the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia were held in New Delhi on 17-18 October, 2019 to discuss the matters relating to operation of Air Services wherein both sides ~~agreed on~~ a memorandum of Understanding (MoU) governing capacity entitlements from 28,000 seats per week to 50,000 seats per week in phased manner, to be signed during the forthcoming High Level meeting between two Countries.

D. TRAFFIC TREND:

Monthly Traffic Reporter for the month of September, 2019 has been prepared and uploaded on AAI website. The broad highlights of Traffic Reporter for the month of September, 2019 and (April- Sept) 2019-20 are as follows: -

SEPTEMBER, 2019 VIS-À-VIS SEPTEMBER, 2018

During the month of September 2019, all Indian airports taken together handled 213.22 thousand aircraft movements (excluding General Aviation Movements), 27.75 million passengers and 284.24 thousand tonnes of freight. The passenger traffic have increased by 0.2% while the aircraft movements and freight has decreased by 5.7% and 5.8% respectively during September, 2019 over September, 2018.

(APRIL- SEPTEMBER) 2019-20 VIS-À-VIS (APRIL- SEPTEMBER) 2018-19

During the period of (April-September) 2019-20, all Indian airports taken together handled 1271.40 thousand aircraft movements (excluding General Aviation Movements), 170.02 million passengers and 1707.98 thousand tonnes of freight. The passenger traffic have increased by 0.3% while aircraft movements and freight traffic have decreased by 1.2% and 4.9% respectively during the period under study.

E. In continuation of AAI initiatives towards environment protection, a commitment was made by AAI to MoCA for making the remaining 30 operational AAI Airports as "Single Use Plastic Free Airport Terminals" on 28th Oct 2019. These 30 airports are Agatti, Adampur, Agra, Bhatinda, Bhavnagar, Bikaner, Diu, Gwalior, Hubli, Jaisalmer, Jalgaon, Jharsuguda, Kadapa, Kandla, Kanpur, Kishangarh, Kolhapur, Kullu, Lilabari, Ludhiana,

Mysore, Pakyong, Pant Nagar, Pathankot, Porbandar, Puducherry, Salem, Shillong, Shimla and Tezpur.
