Subject: Movement of Indian Nationals to travel abroad

In continuation to Ministry of Home Affairs Order No. 40-3/2020-DM-I (A) dated 24.05.2020 and in supersession of MHA O.M. of even no. dated 01.06.2020, the undersigned is directed to say that para - B 2 (ii) of Standard Operating Protocol (SOP) for movement of persons stranded in India who are desirous to travel abroad is substituted by the following:

“Only those persons shall be allowed to travel to the destination countries, who are citizens of that country; who have green card or Permanent Residency Status or OCI card or any other special status in that country; those who are stranded in close neighbouring countries and permitted to exit through India; Indian nationals who are holding any type of visa of any country (other than visa for tourism purpose) if they hold a visa of that country with a minimum residual validity of one month.

All such travel shall be entirely at the risk of the person seeking to travel, bearing in mind the existing restrictions on international travel.”
